Information for authors

1 Aims and scope

Advances in Polar Science (APS) is an international, English-language, peer-reviewed journal that publishes scientific research results concerning the Arctic and Antarctic regions across a broad range of disciplines. It is sponsored by the Polar Research Institute of China. APS is a true open-access journal, with no publication fees and all articles are freely accessible as soon as they are released.

APS is a quarterly journal published in March, June, September and December, and circulated both nationally and internationally. Formerly known as the *Chinese Journal of Polar Science* (English Edition), founded in 1990, this journal is known as *Advances in Polar Science* from Volume 22 (2011).

The journal contains several categories:

Reviews: Summarizes representative results and achievements in a particular topic or an area, comments on the current situation, and advice on research directions. Author opinions and related discussions are invited.

Opinion Editorials: Provides a forum to comment on the status and/or deficiencies of any aspect of polar science, to reflect on recent innovation or progress, and to promote internationally collaborative polar science projects.

Articles: Reports important original results in all areas of polar science.

Letters: Briefly presents novel and innovative findings related to polar science.

Trends: Reports important scientific news, information, and academic affairs, as well as major international programs or conferences in all areas of polar science.

2 Open access

APS is a subsidized open access journal where Polar Research Institute of China pays the OA fee. Authors do not have to pay any open access publication fee. Peer review under the responsibility of Polar Research Institute of China.

2.1 Access rights

All articles published open access will be immediately and permanently free for everyone to read, download, copy and distribute.

2.2 User rights

Permitted third party reuse is defined by the following user license.

Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-NoDerivs (CC BY-NC-ND):

Allows users to copy and distribute the Article, provided this is not done for commercial purposes and further does not permit distribution of the Article if it is changed or edited in any way, and provided the user gives appropriate credit (with a link to the formal publication through the relevant DOI), provides a link to the license, and that the licensor is not represented as endorsing the use made of the work. 2.3 Author rights

For open access publishing, this journal uses an exclusive licensing agreement. Authors will transfer copyright to Polar Research Institute of China, but will have the right to share their article in the same way permitted to third parties under the relevant user license, as well as certain scholarly usage rights.
